# The emotional and physical needs of the child now and in the future

- He is in counseling to address the issues which brought him into care
- He is in after-school programs at Boys and Girls Club and is doing well in school

- He is in 2<sup>nd</sup> grade and is doing better in school. He was significantly behind but is catching up.

has been diagnosed with Post Traumatic Stress Disorder and Physical Abuse of a Child (victim).

- still has outbursts and temper tantrums, particularly when she does not get her way.
- All of her physical and emotional needs are being met at this time.
- She is currently in group and individual counseling
- She is doing well in school (3<sup>rd</sup> grade) and is passing all classes. The school reports no behavior issues at this time.
- with sleep, reduce aggression, depression, mode swings, and ADHD

## The emotional and physical danger to the child now and in the future

 All three children suffer emotionally from the trauma they have experienced repeatedly in their lives

- All three children have experienced physical and emotional abuse at the hands of their parents
- They have seen their mother and dad fight
- All three children have stated that they do not want to live with their father

#### The Parenting abilities of those seeking custody of the children

- All three children were returned to their mother in August, 2014, and three week later she tested positive for drug use.
- During that time she had not enrolled all the children in school nor had she followed up with medical appointments for the children

#### The Plans for the Children by the Agency and CASA

- After repeatedly asking both parents for names of kin that the children could possibly live with, CASA conducted a SENECA Search and have been in contact with several paternal family members who have very much expressed a desire to have the children live with them- either all together in one home of spread out among the family. CASA and CPS are exploring these options at this time.
- CASA has also reached out to a former foster parent for who has expressed interest in possibly becoming a long-term or adoptive home for CASA and CPS are also in communication with this person.
- It is my belief that these children will be placed with family members if that becomes an option.

## The Stability of the parents

- As far as CASA knows, the parents are living in a hotel. That was the last information provided to me on 2/16
- Mom did well and the children were returned to her but she relapsed on drugs after only 3 weeks
- CASA is not aware of any jobs or other means of support by either mom or dad.

## Acts or omissions of the parents which may indicate that the existing parentchild relationship is not a proper one

- Physical and emotional abuse of the children
- Lack of stable housing, means of support, safe and stable drug-free environment
